

First Time Full-Time Freshman Graduation Rates

By cohort as reported to IPEDS



Normal time is defined as the amount of time necessary for a student to complete all requirements for a degree or certificate according to Calvary's catalog. This is typically 4 years for a bachelor's degree, 2 years for an associate's degree and one year for a certificate. 150% of normal time would then be 6, 3, or 1.50 years respectively.
