

2015 Federal Income Tax Filers

Complete this section if the student and spouse filed or will file a 2015 IRS income tax return(s). *The best way to verify income is by using the IRS Data Retrieval Tool (IRS DRT) that is part of FAFSA on the Web at FAFSA.gov.* In most cases, no further documentation is needed to verify 2015 income information that was transferred into the student's FAFSA using the IRS DRT if that information was not changed.

- I (and my spouse, if married) filed taxes in 2015 (**and**)
- I have used the IRS Data Retrieval Tool in FAFSA on the Web to transfer my 2015 IRS income information into my FAFSA (either on the initial FAFSA or a correction to the FAFSA).

 - I am unable to use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool, and I will submit copies of my 2015 Federal Tax return Transcript (NOT a copy of the tax return form) to Calvary. (*To obtain an IRS tax return transcript, go to www.irs.gov and under the Tools heading click "Get Transcript of Your Tax Records".*) Make sure to request the "IRS Tax Return Transcript" and **NOT** the "IRS Tax Account Transcript."
- (Married students only) I and my spouse filed separately in 2015 and I will submit copies of our 2015 Federal Tax Return Transcripts (NOT copies of the tax return form).
- (Married Students only) I and my spouse filed jointly in 2015, but we are now separated. I will provide a copy of our 2015 Federal Tax Return Transcript (NOT copies of the tax return form) along with all of my 2015 W-2's.
