## Scholarship Auditions Calvary University Theatre Arts

As an incoming freshman to CU Theatre Arts, you're eligible for a one-time \$350 scholarship. It's not a huge amount, but it should at least buy your first semester books!

## Please prepare the following:

- Two contrasting memorized monologues that need to be chosen from any of the following, but should show your versatility as an actor:
  - A one to two-minute comedic contemporary monologue (anything published within the last fifty years by an established playwright from a play recognized as solid dramatic literature; generic monologues found on the internet aren't encouraged)
  - A one to two-minute comedic classical monologue (anything published more than fifty years ago of established literary value such as Shakespeare, Moliere, Rostand, etc.)
  - o A one to two-minute dramatic contemporary monologue
  - A one to two-minute dramatic classical monologue
- A sixteen to thirty-two measure cutting from a Broadway show tune (only if you're a singer and feel this would help your chances of receiving a scholarship)
  - o Please bring a recorded accompaniment
