SUBJECT: 2019 Student Satisfaction Inventory Report

Calvary students took the Noel-Levitz Student Satisfaction Inventory (SSI) on March 25, 2019. This report is the complete results of that survey. Noel-Levitz provided a comparison between Calvary and other four-year private institutions as part of their report. Information from that comparison is provided in tables below.

Following the initial report comparing Calvary with national four-year private colleges is a report comparing Calvary to other ABHE schools that took the same survey.

The final section is the written comments from students that were submitted with the SSI. The comments contained in this report are EDITED.
