Calvary University acknowledges it signed and returned to the U.S. Department of Education the Certification and Agreement on April 16, 2020, and gives the assurance that Calvary will use more than 50% of the funds received under section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.

The total amount of funds Calvary received on April 26, 2020, from the U.S. Department of Education for distribution to students is \$108,226.00.

The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students under section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act as of December 31, 2020, is \$106,847.56.

The estimated total number of students at Calvary eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants under section 18004(a)(1) of the Cares Act is 320.

The total number of students who received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant under section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act is 163.

The methods used to determine which and how much students receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants are as follows:

- Because fairly evaluating the actual cost to each student caused by the disruption to campus operations due to COVID-19 is next to impossible, we chose to distribute funds to every qualified student.
- Students classified as International Students did not qualify.
- Only students who were enrolled in at least one course during Cycle 5 (when the stay-at-home orders were instituted) AND who were not taking only online courses qualified.
- Because dorm students experienced a greater impact from the disruption of campus operations than did off-campus students, the dorm students were given \$750 each and offcampus students received \$450 each.
- Meals were purchased for COVID-19-exposed or -positive students who were in the dorm during Fall Break when the Cafeteria was closed.
- Additionally, students who completed the Calvary University COVID-19 Emergency Relief Fund Application and submitted acceptable documentation also received reimbursement for the eligible expenses submitted.

The instructions, directions, or guidance provided by Calvary to all students concerning the Emergency Financial Aid Grants were distributed to all students via University email.
