

How to Fulfill Your First *Practical Christian Ministry*

YOUR FIRST SEMESTER'S PRACTICAL CHRISTIAN MINISTRY IS A "CHURCH SEARCH"

During your first semester, focus on finding a local church home. Visit as many different churches as you need while prayerfully seeking which church the Lord would have you attend.

HOW TO RECEIVE YOUR FIRST PRACTICAL CHRISTIAN MINISTRY CREDIT:

- **You will be registered for CM-099: Christian Ministry** in Canvas when you register for your classes.
- **Attend two church services per week:** morning worship service, Sunday School, Bible study, prayer meeting, youth or college Group, etc. Haystack, a missionary prayer group that meets on campus, can count as one of these services.
- **Look for a ministry in a local organization or in the church you have chosen to attend.**
- **Complete the Church/Ministry Form.** This form's questions help you evaluate your experience at your new church home and, if you have found one, at the ministry you have chosen.
- **Have your mentor fill out the mentor form,** preferably with you. It will help you and your mentor evaluate your time in the church and ministry of your choice.
- **If a debriefing is required:** Toward the middle of the semester, you will meet with the Christian Ministry Director for a Debriefing Interview. You must schedule it through the calendar link on Canvas or by signing up on the sheet outside of my office in the East Ed. Building.
 - Fall: last name beginning with letter A-M
 - Spring: last name beginning with letter N-Z

Already have a church home that you will be attending? You can fulfill your credit by attending two church services per week and fulfilling the other requirements listed above.
