## **Official Stance on Hazing**

In accordance with Missouri law ([Danny's Law](#)), Calvary University prohibits any form of hazing involving students, employees, or organizations operating under Calvary's sanction. Hazing is defined as knowingly, actively, and not under duress participating in, soliciting another person to participate in, cause, or plans a willful act, occurring on or off campus, directed against a student or a prospective member, current member, or former member of the university, that knowingly recklessly endangers the mental or physical safety of them for initiation or admission into or continued membership in any such organization. All students are expected to refrain from and not tolerate hazing activities. Hazing should be reported to a ResLife member or someone in the Student Affairs Department.
